THREE INTERN OPPORTUNITIES WITH ROUSTABOUT THEATRE

Roustabout is a Bristol-based theatre company that specialises in creating work for younger and schools' audiences. We recognise that global majority artists are significantly under-represented in the backstage and technical areas of performing arts. In order to help address this shortfall, we have received Arts Council England funding to offer three paid internships for practitioners at the earliest stages of their careers. These internships are designed to give practical, hands-on experience in areas other than performance for young people of global majority heritage who are considering a career in the performing arts.

You are:

- Aged between 18 and 25; from a global majority background; and living in, or within easy travelling distance, of Bristol.
- Passionate about live performance, in particular theatre.
- Seriously considering a career in the non-performance areas of theatre, film or television.

We will:

- Offer you twenty hours of paid work experience and training at £12 per hour.
- Tailor a training programme with you to reflect your skills, interests and future plans. It is likely that this programme will include opportunities to gain experience in stage management, lighting and sound design, costume, set, marketing, and producing.
- Negotiate your hours with you to reflect your current work and education commitments. It is likely that these will be from July 11th onwards.
- Continue to support you informally as you take the next steps in developing your career.
